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FACTS	WHAT DOES CITIZENS COMMUNITY BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
Why?			
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: Social Security number and other identification information Account balances Payment and transaction history Credit history and credit score Income, assets and liabilities Loss and claim history		
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Citizens Community Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing

For our everyday business purposes - such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

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What We Do			
How does Citizens Community Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.		
How does Citizens Community Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Apply for a loan Use your debit card Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.		
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choice to limit sharing will apply to everyone on your account.		
Definitions			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Citizens Community Bank has no affiliates.		
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • Citizens Community Bank does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market		

financial products or services to you.

• Citizens Community Bank doesn't jointly market.
